Division:

“Kids on Ice” – normal skaters with little or no previous competition experience and Junior F.

“Other skaters” – all other skaters with a Belgian, Dutch or Luxembourg Licence. Dutch skaters must belong to a club from the Region NBLZ.

When the event has an unmanageable number of entries the organisers will consult with the KBSF and STB to determine the best course of action.

Category:

Junior F, born after 30-6-2008

Junior E, born between 1-7-2006 and 30-6-2008

Junior D, born between 1-7-2004 and 30-6-2006

Junior C, born between 1-7-2002 and 30-6-2004

Junior A, B and senior born before 1-7-2002

Helmet caps:

All skaters need to have helmet caps. The caps will be handed out before the competition. After the competition the caps need to be returned.

An amount of EUR 20 will be charged to the skater for unreturned helmet caps.

Registration fee

An Invoice with the registration fee will be sent to the clubs. The fee is € 15,00 for each competitor

Safety

All skaters must wear cut-resistant accessories as hand gloves, shin and knee protectors, neck protector and a short track helmet
