### **COURMAYEUR (AO) - ITALY**

**September 29<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> 2018**

The Italian Ice Sport Federation FISG has the honour and pleasure to invite you to the Courmayeur Cup OPEN which will be held at the Courmayeur Forum Sport Center on September 29<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> 2018. The competition will be organized in accordance with the 2018 regulations of the International Skating Union and the conditions included in this announcement.

#### **Entries**

Entries are restricted to invited National Teams whose skaters must have been born before July 1<sup>st</sup> 2004 (i.e. who have turned 14 before July 1<sup>st</sup> 2018).

*Skaters belonging to national teams born after July 1<sup>st</sup> 2004 can be accepted sub judice provided they have qualifying times respecting World Cup 2018/2019 participation criteria.*

Entries should be made on [www.shorttrackonline.info](http://www.shorttrackonline.info); final entries closing on Sunday September 23<sup>rd</sup>.

Italian skaters must also be entered on fisgonline; deadline is also Sunday September 23<sup>rd</sup>.

#### **Entry fee**

An entry fee of Euro 30.00 must be paid for every athlete and for every coach; one coach per club/nation is exempted.

#### **Track**

The track is an artificial refrigerated indoor ice surface with the measures of 30x60 meters, boardless protective padding will be in place according to ISU communication no.2128. The standard track 111,12 meters to the lap with measured curves of 8,50 meters will have 7 markers used to establish the curve. The length of the straight is 28,85 m. Besides the original track there will be 4 tracks set to preserve good ice conditions. For all tracks one finish line will be used.

### **Award of Prizes**

Prizes for the first, second and third classed in the overall classification for each individual category.

### **Qualification**

- Make-up of the first qualifying round of each individual distance will be based on the skater's Distance World Ranking at the end of Season 2017/2018; athletes without a world ranking will be seeded according to their best times on each distance skated in season 2017/2018 or later.
- Final results from each individual distance will be combined to determine an overall classification.

### **Medical assistance**

Doctor and paramedical personnel will be present on competition days. An ambulance will be on standby on site in case of any emergency.

### **Medical Insurance**

It is the sole responsibility of each Member to ensure or provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes. Proof of such may be requested by the Organizing Committee. See I.S.U. Rule 119.



### **Liability**

In accordance with I.S.U. Rule 119, the Organizing Committee assumes no responsibility with respect to medical, bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage sustained or caused in connection with this competition.

### **Ice Training**

Ice training will be available leading up to the competition at the Courmayeur Forum Sport Center at the cost of € 100 per hour (VAT included). If two or more teams agree to share one training session, both (all) of them can share the cost.
