If one Masters group has too few entries, this group will be joined by a higher or lower group depending on the amount of entries in the particular groups. Relay will depend on the number of participants and will be announced on the competition day. The layout of the relay, when time permits, is made by the competition management.

**Criteria for participation:**

Juniors men (A/B/C) limit 500 m < 49/51/53 sec. are excluded
Juniors ladies (A/B/C) limit 500 m < 52/53/55 sec. are excluded
Senior men limit 500 m < 47 sec. are excluded
Senior ladies limit 500 m < 50 sec. are excluded
Masters no limits

Entries:

Closing date:

Final entries must be made at the latest on Tuesday January 30 th 2018.

Entrance fee:

An entrance fee of € 15,- must be paid to the Organizers for every athlete. The warrant for the helmet covers is € 5,- per athlete. The participating athletes are responsible for their own meals and accommodation.

For Dutch athletes, if you have no "wedstrijdlicentie", a "dagwedstrijdlicentie" from the KNSB is available on that day at the competition for € 7,50 per athlete.

Track:

The competition will be held on a 60m x 30m artificial indoor ice surface with a 111.12 m oval track. Four other tracks will be laid out which are moved 1m from the standard track. For all tracks one finish line will be used. Protective padding with a thickness of 30 cm will cover the board.

Conditions of contest:

The qualifying schedule is based on the "all final system". The organizers reserve the right to change the program due to any unforeseen circumstances.

Award of prizes:

In each category the first three skaters will receive an award. The results of this competition will also be part of the series Master competitions for the Silver M award, which will proudly be awarded after the last competition of these series; the Closing Games in Turnhout.

Liability:

All participants have to take care of their own safety in accordance. At the same time participants should be covered by their own national insurance. The organizers cannot be held responsible for any kind of injury or property loss during the competition.
