StarClass season 2010-2011: the countdown has begun! The first Starclass Event is only 7 weeks away!

Here is the season's calendar:

- Milano (Italy) will welcome Starclass, Senior, Jun A and B categories from Oct 8th to 10th.
- Reims (France), a Starclass veteran venue, will see on the ice Jun C and Novice from Nov. 5th to Nov. 7th.
- For the second year, Hasselt (Belgium) will be hosting a Starclass competition from Nov. 26th to 28th in the second event dedicated to Starclass, Senior, Jun A and B categories.
- Mannheim (Germany) will once again welcome the younger skaters (Jun C and Novices) from Dec. 17th to 19th.
- New entry to the Starclass circuit is Odense (Denmark) which will open its rink to the Starclass, Senior, Jun A and B categories from Jan. 7th to 9th
- The Friesland Cup in Leeuwarden (Netherlands) will be the last event for Jun C and Novices from Jan. 21^{st} to 23^{rd} .

Qualified skaters will be invited to participate at the Junior Europa Cup Final which will be in Munich (Germany) from March 4^{th} to 6^{th} .

Six qualifying events this season all on three days to allow for the full program to be followed at every competition; the 2010-2011 Starclass Memorandum with complete rules and regulations is online on www.shorttrackonline.info as is the announcement of the first competition. This year too, shorttrackonline will be following closely all events: it will be hosting entries and results, announcements and news from all the rinks, so stay tuned!
