The Skating Club Courmayeur has the honour and pleasure to invite you to the Courmayeur Cup Test Race OPEN which will be held at the Courmayeur Forum Sport Center on September 4th – September 5th 2021. The competition will be organized in accordance with the 2021 regulations of the International Skating Union and the conditions included in this announcement.

Entries

Entries are restricted to invited National Teams whose skaters must have been born before July 1st 2007 (i.e. who have turned 14 before July 1st 2021).

Skaters belonging to national teams born after July 1st 2007 can be accepted sub judice provided they have qualifying times respecting World Cup 2019/2020 and subsequent participation criteria.

Club skaters not belonging to national teams can also be accepted provided their best times on 500m skated in season 2019/2020 and subsequent are below the following

Women 50,75

Men 47,50

Entries should be made on www.shorttrackonline.info; final entries closing on Sunday August 29th .

Italian skaters must also be entered on fisgonline; deadline is also Sunday August 29th .

Entry fee

An entry fee of Euro 50.00 must be paid for every athlete and for every coach; one coach per club/nation is exempted.

Track

The track is an artificial refrigerated indoor ice surface with the measures of 30x60 meters, boardless protective padding will be in place according to ISU



communication no.2128 and subsequent. The standard track 111,12 meters to the lap with measured curves of 8,50 meters will have 7 markers used to establish the curve. The length of the straight is 28,85 m. Besides the original track there will be 6 tracks set to preserve good ice conditions. For all tracks one finish line will be used.

Board and Lodging

Qualification

- Make-up of the first qualifying round of each individual distance will be based on the skater's Distance World Ranking at the end of Season 2020/2021; athletes without a world ranking will be seeded according to their best times on each distance skated in season 2019/2020 or later.
- Final results from each individual distance will be combined to determine an overall classification.

Medical assistance

Doctor and paramedical personnel will be present on competition days. An ambulance will be on standby on site in case of any emergency.



Medical Insurance

It is the sole responsibility of each Member to ensure or provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes. Proof of such may be requested by the Organizing Committee. See I.S.U. Rule 119.

COVID Protocol

All skaters and accompanying officials must have a valid GREEN PASS or a negative test carried out in the 48 hrs preceding the competition. Any updated local/national measures will be announced, if necessary, and will have to be strictly followed by all participants.

Liability

In accordance with I.S.U. Rule 119, the Organizing Committee assumes no responsibility with respect to medical, bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage sustained or caused in connection with this competition.

Ice Training

Ice training will be available leading up to the competition at the Courmayeur Forum Sport Center at the cost of € 100 per hour (VAT included). If two or more teams agree to share one training session, both (all) of them can share the cost.
