On October 11th until October 13rd 2024, the “Energiesportverein Turbine Rostock” and the “Deutsche Eisschnelllauf und Shorttrack Gemeinschaft DESG” will organize at the “Eishalle Rostock” in “Schillingallee 51, 18057 Rostock,” the HANSE CUP competition in Short Track Speed Skating.

The competition will be organized in accordance with the 2022¹ Regulations of the International Skating Union and the conditions included in this announcement.

The competition is organized to support the activities in speed skating in the province of Mecklenburg-Vorpommern and is sponsored by STADTWERKE ROSTOCK, WOHNUNGSGENOSSENSCHAFT SCHIFFAHT-HAFEN, VR BANK MECKLENBURG und PARKEN & MEER.

Categories for Women and Men

Age before July the 1st preceding the competition:

Junior A + Senior	17 and 29	born between July 1 st 1995 and June 30 st 2007
Junior B	15 and 16	born between July 1 st 2007 and June 30 th 2009
Junior C	13 and 14	born between July 1 st 2009 and June 30 th 2011
Junior D	11 and 12	born between July 1 st 2011 and June 30 th 2013
Junior E	9 and 10	born between July 1 st 2013 and June 30 th 2015
Junior F	7 and 8	born between July 1 st 2015 and June 30 th 2017
Master	30 and older	born before June 30 st 1995

Conditions of Contest

The Qualifying Schedule on each distance shall be based on an "All Final System" in all categories. The All Final System is used in order to guarantee a minimum number of races to all participants. The organizer reserves the right to change the program due to extremely unforeseen circumstances. For all other items of the Conditions of Contest see the ISU Regulations. Points for each Distance Classification will be awarded in accordance with Rule 295, paragraph 6. The Overall Classification will be calculated in accordance with Rule 295, paragraph 8. Skaters who did not start in the first round of any of the distances with a valid reason, e.g. a medical reason, will get a ranking on that distance equal to the number of participants plus 1.

The program is tentative and subject to changes by the organizing club. A detailed program will be published on www.shortrackonline.info in the week before the competition.

Entries

For all categories the entries close 10 days before the competition. Entries can be made by Clubs but it is the responsibility of the Clubs to have the necessary permission from their ISU Member. In case of an unmanageable number of entries in one or more categories the organizers may close the entries for the respective categories before October 1st. In this way a first come first serve procedure applies and the final entries on the moment of the closing of entries will participate.

The preliminary entry form must be submitted not later than September 17th 2024 and shall be made via www.shorttrackonline.info

The FINAL ENTRY specifying/confirming:

- surname, first name and gender of the competitors
- date of birth of the competitors
- best time on the 500 m distance in the 2023-2024 season
- name of the accompanying Officials

The final entry form must be submitted not later than October 1st 2024 and shall be made via www.shorttrackonline.info

ALL TEAMLEADERS are very urgently requested to inform the Organizers of any changes upon departure from their home-town, at the very latest.

Entry Fee

An entry fee of EUR 60,00 must be paid to the Organizers for each accredited person, e.g. for every athlete and for every coach/team leader. Per Club two coaches or two team leaders does not have to pay the Entry Fee. For safety reasons the access to the track will be allowed only to the athletes and the accredited people.

Registration, competition accreditation and helmet cover handout will be open on Thursday, October 10th 2024, from 17:00 to 19:00 and on Friday, October 11th 2024, from 07:00, directly at the ice rink.

Helmet cover deposit

We distribute stickers with start numbers. No deposit will be charged.

Meals at Ice Rink

On the competition days (Friday to Sunday), we offer an all-day buffet with a selection of cold dishes (fruit, vegetables, cakes, rolls) and drinks (coffee, tea and water); this buffet is included in the entry fee for registered athletes and coaches.

In addition, we offer a warm lunch (pasta) - also as a vegetarian option - for everyone. The cost for this is EUR 10 per meal/per day/per person. The amount will be collected together with the registration fee on the day of registration and we ask you to make a reservation in good time via shorttrackonline.info.

Track

The track is an artificial refrigerated indoor ice surface with the measures of 30x60 meters. The standard track 111,12 meters to the lap with measured curves of 8,50 meters and there will be 7 markers used to establish each curve. The length of the straight is 28,85 meters. In addition to the original track, 6 additional tracks will be built (a total of 7 tracks) to maintain good ice conditions. For all tracks one finish line will be used. The padding system is a traditional, fixed padding system.

Officiating

The Officials for the Competition are appointed by the Organizers.

To determine the order of finish and the times skated in each race photofinish equipment will be used.

To support the observation of racing rules infringements the RDC Video Replay System will be used.

Award of Prizes

Prize for the first - second and third skater in the final of each distance and for the first, second **and** third skater in the final results for each category - women and men. During award ceremonies, the skaters should be in club or national track suits.

Medical Assistance

Doctor and paramedical personnel will be present at the competition days. An ambulance will be on standby in case of need.

Medical Insurance

It is the sole responsibility of each Member, on behalf of its participating clubs, to ensure or provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes. Proof of such may be requested by the Organizing Committee. See I.S.U. Rule 119.

Liability

In accordance with I.S.U. Rule 119, the Organizing Committee assumes no responsibility with respect to medical, bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage sustained or caused in connection with this Competition.
